- a. Student attendance: 395 students have returned to Sparks ES for 4 days per week in-person learning. That is 85% of all Sparks ES students.
- b. Parent Loop procedure has improved and pace has picked up.
- c. All kids are now eating in the cafeteria, with tables spread out into the gym. All students are still 6 feet apart. Update: **Students now must only be 3 feet apart in the classrooms.**
- d. Fall updates: School will be 5 day in-person in the Fall. there will be a virtual learning option that will require a one year commitment by parents. This program will be centralized to BCPS and students will not have Sparks ES teachers. Sparks ES would still be their "home school" and would be able to receive services and attend activities/sports through Sparks ES.
- e. Summer Learning Hike- BCPS will use this program again this summer for summer learning. All students will keep their laptops over the summer.
