- 2. School Updates (Ms. Chyko and Ms. Alvarez)
 - a. Superintendent Williams visited 10/12. Went well!

 - f. The Shivers!!! The Shivers is a school-wide positive behavior plan. Surveys have shown a 20% gap between School Pride at Sparks and feeling of belonging. This program hopes to bridge that gap for students.
 - Students will be assigned to a "shiver" (like the houses in Harry Potter). Sharks hunt in "shivers", hence the name. All students and staff/employees will have a shiver assignment and coordinating color.
 - All adults in the building will have tickets to award to students for exemplifying shiver behaviors being promoted. Tickets will earn points for your shiver.
